The North Norfolk Classic Vehicle Club invite you to join us with your classic, collectable, unusual or interesting vehicle for our run in 2018 which is part of the "Drive It Day" initiative of the Federation of British Historic Vehicle Club which celebrates the 1000 mile trial organized by the RAC which started on 23<sup>rd</sup> April 1900 . Cars, commercial vehicles, motorcycles and military are all welcome to participate in our run.

Our run will start from Station Road Car Park, Sheringham NR26 8RE with the lineup starting from 8.30am with the first vehicles being waved away at around 9.30 am. Don't forget to fly your flag of St George!  
There will be two routes going through the North Norfolk countryside which will finish by kind permission of the Earl of Leicester, at Holkham Hall, via the South Gate NR23 1RU. **If you did the Red Route last year ask for the Green Route this time and vice versa. Clue :- if you went through the Triumphal Arch at Holkham in 2017 you were on the Green Route** **Dogs are allowed but MUST be kept on a lead at ALL times.**

Refreshments including bacon butties , tea or coffee will be available at the start.

The Courtyard Café at Holkham Hall offers homemade soup, hot pasties and sausage rolls, a choice of two hot lunches, freshly made sandwiches and salads or delicious pork pies, and many other snacks Freshly baked scones , Holkham signature coffee, and a varied cake selection. The Court Yard Café offers gluten free and vegetarian options. Speak to the staff.

There will be a special discount of 20% to the normal attractions. This will only be available upon production of the discount voucher contained in your route book at the start of the run.
